On the heels of the announcement of the new Goddard, Kansas, aquatics complex being developed by [Rodney Steven II](#), Rock Construction has been awarded as the general contractor for the project.

The multimillion-dollar complex located at 19800 block of West Kellogg will include state of the art facilities including a competitive natatorium; indoor water park, a Genesis Health Club, childcare facility and an attached hotel. The complex will also consist of five baseball fields that will also accommodate softball, one of which will be full turf. There was a ground breaking ceremony held Monday Nov 6th, and site work will begin soon.

Jason Layman and Rodney Steven II have been working together since 1999. Rock Construction has performed a multitude of projects with Mr. Steven's, with scopes ranging from \$20,000 to \$10,000,000 in both remodels and new construction of health clubs, childcare facilities, indoor and outdoor tennis courts, Olympic pools and water parks.

"This project is fitting of our abilities, just a little larger scale." Says Amber Dobosz, Co-Owner of Rock Construction. "We are appreciative that Rodney has chosen to extend our relationship and build an exciting project for the City of Goddard and surrounding communities."

Queer Eye Netflix Original Seasons 3 & 4


